

# Celebrating Leaders in English Tourism: VisitEngland announces Awards for Excellence finalists

VisitEngland, the national tourist board has announced the finalists for the Awards for Excellence 2016, the most prestigious awards in English Tourism. The winners will be announced at the Award ceremony on Tuesday 8 March at the Winter Gardens, Blackpool.

With 16 categories ranging from Access for All to Visitor Information Provider of the Year and 2016's debut Dog Friendly Business of the Year Award, applications were received from a variety of businesses including hotels, B&Bs, glamping operators, restaurants, food and drink producers, pubs, museums, festivals, conference centres and even motorway service areas.

"Awards for Excellence finalists exemplify outstanding tourism talent and distinguished businesses throughout England," said Sally Balcombe, CEO of VisitBritain and VisitEngland. "Our Awards highlight exceptional commitment to quality care, service and English tourism as a whole. The Awards not only honour the great and the good in tourism and hospitality, but raise the profile of England and celebrate the importance of the industry's contribution to local and national economies."

Judged by industry leaders, all finalists will receive either a Gold, Silver, Bronze or Highly Commended Award.

The Awards ceremony will also include the official presentation of the VisitEngland and Daily Mirror's Tourism Superstar 2016 Award for the nation's publically voted unsung tourism hero.
